Since then, many organizations have found that labor markets have shifted, digitization and virtualization have accelerated transformation in sales and support models, and we have driven much deeper into a significant generational transition. During this session, we'll explore issues that companies need to consider addressing as we move toward the final stages of the pandemic and into an environment that is likely to be characterized by faster cycle times and increased competition at many levels.
