The 2023 LIC Summer CEO Forum drew nearly 50 participants to Park City, Utah. Being near the Navajo Reservation, we partnered with Adopt-A-Native-Elder (A.N.E.) to help make an impact on the extreme poverty and hardship facing traditional Elders living there. A.N.E. is a trusted humanitarian organization focused on delivering food, medical supplies, firewood and other forms of Elder support. Respecting the tradition and dignity of Navajo Elders, A.N.E. helps create relationships and honor and serve the Elders.

The Program is organized in the Native American Spirit of the Giveaway Circle, a tradition of giving the best that we have. That may be a gift of time, talents or skills, or actual gifts of food and donations.

Through the generosity of LIC CEO Forum participants, here is how we were able to help:

- 14 baskets of food were donated for A.N.E. to distribute to the Elders
- \$175 in gift cards donated for Elders to purchase essentials on the Reservation
- Almost \$5,000 in Navajo rugs and jewelry were sold at the event, with 100% of the proceeds going to the Elders
